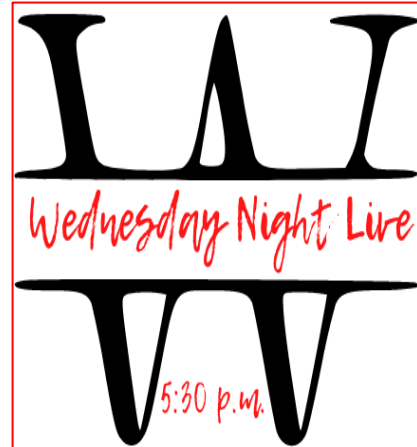

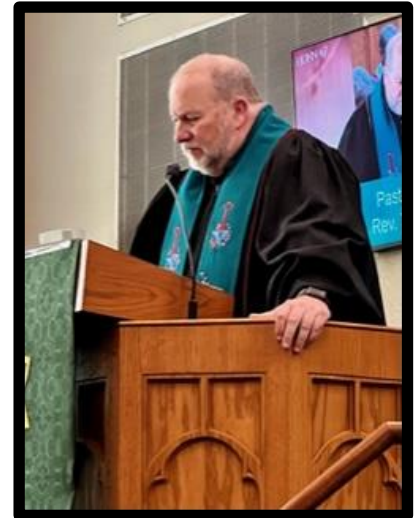

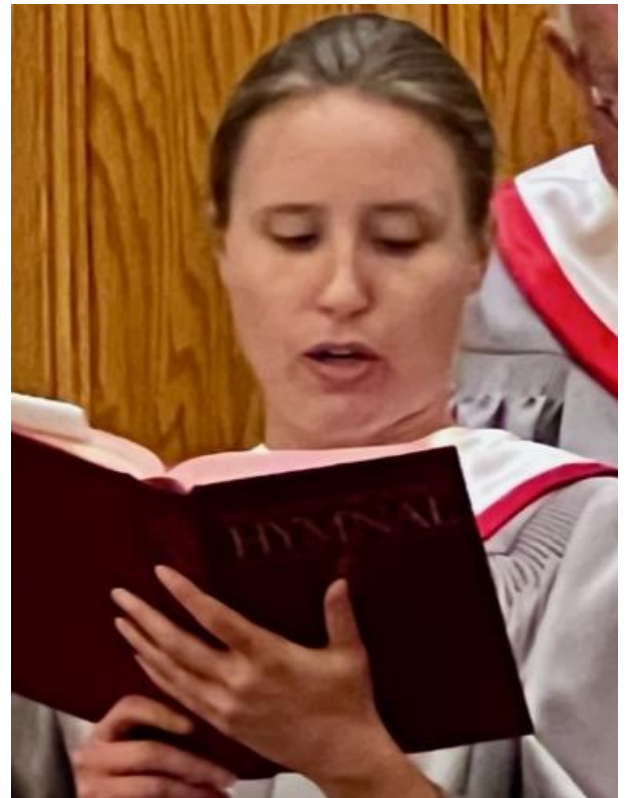


Linda Smith blessed us with a reading from the Psalms
