HISTORY HIGHLIGHT

130th Anniversary in 2023

Did you know.....

The First Methodist Church of Ponca City was established October 8, 1893, just 22 days after the opening of the Cherokee Strip Land Run which took place on September 16. The creation of the church was brought about at the close of the 11AM church service held in the home of one of its first members. This Sunday class was claimed to be the first such class held in the Strip. It was organized after the Wesleyan tradition under the direction of Rev. B.C. Swartz with the assistance of J.E. Irvine who had been appointed to a large circuit of American Indian and White settlers. His territory included the Ponca, Otoe, and Osage reservations.

Rev. Swartz's leadership continued until the Rev. E.C. Harper was assigned on April 1, 1894, as a supply pastor. Following, Rev. Harper was permanently appointed to the church on October 1 as its regular pastor. When Rev. Harper arrived from Nebraska, a new church building had already been built. The building was located on two 25 ft. lots at the southwest corner of 6th St. and Central Ave. where our church stands today. The lots had

been purchased as church property for \$50.

The new church building was dedicated on September 16, 1894, as the *Methodist Episcopal Church*, exactly one year from the original Cherokee Strip Land Run date. At the time of dedication, the building and its contents were entirely paid for. For that reason, the church claimed the distinction of being the first church organized in the new territory.

The structure was 28 ft. by 48 ft. with a small tower and vestibule. While there is no record of the exact cost, it was thought to be well under \$1000. Rev. Harper served as pastor thru 1898. During his tenure he never received more than \$250 per year in salary, although his annual salary had been set at \$500 per year.
